



Hidden Infection



Hidden infections are often the thing that keeps many people from getting their lives back. They are difficult to detect and difficult to get rid of. They come in the form of root canals that harbor anaerobic bacteria that no antibiotic or herbal killer can reach because they are deep in microtubules that remain, even after the root is extracted. Cavitations in the jaw left behind from tooth extractions (like wisdom teeth) will often leave a space that breeds infection.
